

Who Can Enter

Winner Selection and Prizes

All eligible entries will be judged by a panel of scientists, engineers, and educators, based on the following criteria: (1) originality of idea; (2) originality and creative quality of essay; (3) clarity of the presentation; (4) writing ability and content; (5) significance of technology; (6) relevance to the topic

Awards include the following prizes:

1st place - \$500 and a trophy

2nd place - \$250 and a trophy

3rd place - \$100 and a trophy
